Day 01 : Arrival in Budapest (Hungary)

Welcome to your Eastern Europe tour! Upon arrival in Budapest, transfer to the hotel. Enjoy overnight at hotel in Budapest. (Meals: D)



Day 02 : Budapest – Guided City Tour – Hungarian Horsemanship Show

Today after breakfast, join an experienced English-speaking local guide to see the sights of Budapest. See the Heroes Square, Parliament Building, Széchenyi Chain Bridge and other sights and also visit the Buda Castle – a medieval castle and now an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later proceed to witness the acrobats of the Hungarian Horsemen on the Hungarian Horsemanship Show. Get delighted with the stunts and skills of the horses and their riders. Tonight, enjoy dinner. Enjoy overnight stay in Budapest. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 03 : Vienna (Austria) – Guided City Tour

Today after breakfast, check out and drive to the Austrian Capital – Vienna. On arrival, enjoy lunch and proceed for a city tour of Vienna with an experienced English speaking local guide. Start your tour

with a visit to the Schonbrunn Palace – one of the most visited places in Vienna. See the various chambers of the palace and the beautiful gardens. Also, see the Opera House, St. Stephens Cathedral, Hofburg Palace and many more sights. Tonight, enjoy dinner and overnight stay in Vienna. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 04 : Vienna – Seegrotte & Vienna Woods – Prague (Czechia) – Orientation Tour – Cruise on Vltava River

Today after breakfast, check out visit the Seegrotte in the Vienna woods from where you can also enjoy great views of this beautiful city and the Donau Canal. After lunch, drive to the Czech Capital – Prague. On arrival visit the Old Town Square for a feel of this city. See the astronomical clock on the town hall and the famous Charles Bridge. Later, check in to your hotel. This evening, proceed for a local dinner cruise on the Vltava River with a local guide. Overnight stay in Prague. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 05 : Prague – Guided City Tour – Free time for shopping

Today after breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Prague with an experienced English speaking local guide. Start off with a visit to the Prague Castle. Walk through the many courtyards; visit the St. Vitus Cathedral – the main church of the castle and the Golden Lane to see the brightly coloured houses lined along the castle wall. Later, drive around the medieval part of the city. After lunch, afternoon is free for you to relax in your hotel or explore the shopping opportunities that this city offers. Tonight, enjoy dinner and overnight stay in Prague. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 06 : Dresden (Germany) – Guided City Tour – Berlin (Germany), visit Berlin Tower

Today after breakfast, check out and proceed to the German town of Dresden which was destroyed during World War II and later restored to its original 18th Century glory. Join an experienced English speaking local guide to see the Opera House and stroll through Theatre Platz. Visit the Zwinger Palace with all its beautiful fountains. After lunch, drive to the city of Berlin and check in to your hotel. Later, in the evening visit the Berlin Tower. Tonight, enjoy dinner and overnight stay in Berlin. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 07 : Berlin – Guided City Tour – Drive to Rostock (Germany)

Today after breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Berlin with an experienced English-speaking local guide to see the city where Hitler rose to power. See the remains of the Berlin Wall, the Brandenburg Gate and the Reichstag – the German Parliament Building. Visit Alexander Platz in the city centre where you will see the World Clock. After lunch, drive to Rostock. On arrival check-in to hotel and enjoy dinner at hotel. Enjoy overnight stay in Rostock. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 08 : Warsaw (Poland) – City Tour

Today after breakfast, proceed for flight transfer to Warsaw (Poland). Upon arrival, enjoy City Tour of Warsaw. Explore Poland's resilient and modern capital city on an afternoon sightseeing tour by coach. Cover most of the major landmarks, including the

Royal Castle, King Sigismund III's Column, Holy Cross Church, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, a historic vodka factory, and the UNESCO-listed Old Town, faithfully rebuilt after the destruction of World War II. Enjoy overnight stay in Warsaw. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 09 : Warsaw – Krakow – Visit Auschwitz-Birkenau, the Original Nazi Concentration Camp – City Tour of Krakow

Today after breakfast, proceed for a sobering visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau. At Auschwitz-Birkenau, visit still-standing parts of the original Nazi concentration camps along with artifacts from the prisoners who perished there during World War II. Learn about the murderous Nazi campaigns against Europe's Jewish populations and other 'undesirables' as you tour the camps. Change pace back in Krakow, proceed for the City Tour, taking in landmarks including Town Hall Tower, St. Mary's Basilica, Krakow Barbican, and Wawel Hill with its castle and cathedral. Return to Warsaw in the evening. Enjoy overnight stay in Warsaw. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 10 : Ljubljana (Slovenia)

Today arrive into Slovenia and into the city of Ljubljana. Check into your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore some of Ljubljana, Slovenia's capital, with a strong alpine architectural flavor. Enjoy overnight stay in Ljubljana. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 11 : Ljubljana – Postojna Caves

This morning you will take a journey south to visit Postojna Caves. This is the longest cave system in Slovenia and was created by the Pivka River. Even on a hot summer's day, the caves maintain an evenly cool temperature. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 12 : Ljubljana – Bled – Zagreb (Croatia) – Plitvice

Afterwards, you will continue to Bled, beautifully set in a charming location on a lake of the same name with a romantic island in the center. It is a great region for sports at all times of the year. The next day you will have a sightseeing tour of Bled to view the main features and visit the imposing Bled Castle, one of the oldest medieval fortresses in Slovenia. As the residence of the Bishops of Bixen, the fortress was noted in documents dating back to 1004. From the terraces there are magnificent views over the entire area. Next travel to Zagreb. Here you enjoy visiting the historic Upper Town, which is set in the hills and where religious, political and a city tour featuring the administrative power is located. Many of the buildings were restored following the devastating earthquake in 1880. You will see the Cathedral of St. Stephen with its tall spire. Later Proceed to Plitvice National Park. Overnight in Plitvice National Park (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 13 : Plitvice National Park

Today enjoy time at Plitvice National Park. Enjoy a walk with a Local Guide through the breathtaking scenery of this natural wonder. It is surrounded with 16 lakes, wooded hills, waterfalls, and cascades make it one of Europe's most loved national parks. Enjoy overnight stay at the Plitvice National Park area. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 14 : Plitvice – Trogir – Split

After Breakfast, proceed to Trogir. Set on a small island and joined to the Main Island by a Bridge. Then, drive south to Split to visit the former hometown of Roman Emperor Diocletian, his Palace and Jupiter Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See more of the lovely Dalmatian Coast before reaching Split. Overnight stay in Split. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 15 : Split – Mostar (Bosnia and Herzegovina) – Sarajevo

Today depart to Sarajevo. En route, we will pass by and visit Mostar, where a Local Guide shows you the Turkish Quarter with the Turkish House, the Mosque and the reconstructed 16th-century bridge. Continue road transfer to Sarajevo, capital of Bosnia-Herzegovina and certainly the most Turkish-looking city in the Balkans—famous for its mosques, markets, and bazaars. Discover the city with a Local Guide and get acquainted with its architectural highlights, including the Gazi Husrev-Beg Mosque. Enjoy overnight stay in Sarajevo. (Meals: B, L, D)



Day 16 : Sarajevo – Enter the nation of Montenegro & Visit towns of Risan, Kotor & Cetinje & Villages of Sveti Sefan & Budva

This morning you will travel to the Republic of Montenegro. You will head towards the mouth of the beautiful Bay of Kotor, the longest and deepest fjord in Southern Europe. You will see the little towns of Risan and Kotor. Then proceed to Cetinje, once the seat of Montenegrin rulers, today a city-museum. After the sightseeing in Cetinje, you will travel to the coast for a short stop in the villages of Sveti Stefan and Budva before your overnight stay. **(Meals: B, L, D)**



Day 17 : Montenegro – Dubrovnik (Croatia)

Today transfer to Dubrovnik by road. Enjoy the local sightseeing tour. Dubrovnik is the best-preserved Croatian medieval city and the liveliest in Dalmatia. Visit the Franciscan Monastery and the Rector Palaces, where the Local Guide will give you a full commentary, including the history of this beautifully preserved medieval architectural wonder. Enjoy overnight stay in Dubrovnik. **(Meals: B, L, D)**



Day 18 : Dubrovnik – Full Day Sightseeing in Dubrovnik featuring Walls of Dubrovnik

Today enjoy full day sightseeing at Dubrovnik, featuring a visit to the Walls of Dubrovnik, which served as a series of defensive stone walls surrounding the city and are considered to be among the great fortification systems of the Middle Ages. Enjoy overnight stay in Dubrovnik. **(Meals: B, L, D)**

Day 19 : Departure

This morning, after breakfast, check out of the hotel and proceed to the airport for your flight back home. Return home with wonderful memories of your holiday with us. **(Meals: B)**
